




# The River Ports of Arkansas



A **port** is defined as an area on both land and water, whether on the sea or river, that provides facilities for shipping vessels to load and unload their cargo. Ports provide a unique opportunity for economic development, multi-modal shipping, and supplying jobs and sales impacts for surrounding communities, regions and the nation. The higher the throughput of goods year-on-year, the more infrastructure, provisions, and associated services are required. These will bring varying degrees of benefit to the local and regional economy, as well as the environment.

This guide covers opportunities for industrial development at the public river ports in the State of Arkansas. The people at the ports are eager to work with industry leaders in order to better impact the economy.

## The Ouachita River







# The Mississippi River






**Location:** 5117 North Levee Rd Arkansas City, AR 71630



Box 407, Helena, AR 72342 Location: Helena Harbor is located in Phillips County in the eastern part of Arkansas (known as the Arkansas Delta) along the Mississippi River at mile 652 SH 20 accesses the port location just south of the city of Helena-West Helena.

**Land Available:** Helena Harbor occupies 4,000 acres of prime land which is mostly undeveloped or utilized for agricultural uses, providing abundant space for future new development.

Details: The area has convenient access to major rail lines provided by Union Pacific with Arkansas Midland providing the switching service to the port site. There is also water transportation via the Mississippi River, and major interstate highways, as well as regional and international airports. The U.S. Route 49 Mississippi River crossing is one of only four bridges crossing the Mississippi River in the state of Arkansas.
